- **[Game Fowl Fighting Amendments SB112S01](#)**: Makes it a felony for those who breed, train or fight game fowl and a misdemeanor for spectators of the fights.  
Bill status: Approved in the Senate. Heading to a House committee. #SB112
- **[Environmental Protection Amendments SB164](#)**: Repeals current laws so Utah is allowed to establish stronger rules than the federal Clean Air Standard.  
Bill status: On the Senate calendar waiting for a vote. #SB164

- **[Voter Information Amendments SB36S01](#)**: Changes parts of the Election Code to ensure the personal information of registered voters is protected from commercial use.  
Bill status: Approved in the Senate. Heading to a House committee. #SB36
- **[Municipal Formation Amendments SB216](#)**: Forms a new Salt Lake County government structure, which would protect townships by giving them ownership of their services and a say on how they govern themselves.  
Bill status: In Senate committee. #SB216

- **[School Funding Through Income Tax Revisions SB118S01](#)**: Modifies the taxpayer tax credit calculation, thus creating the School-Level Funding Program to allocate money to public schools for school improvement plans.  
Bill status: On the Senate calendar waiting for a vote. #SB118
- **[Financial and economic literacy amendments, SB40S01](#)**: Modifies provisions relating to financial and economic literacy.  
Bill status: On the House calendar waiting for a vote. #SB40

- **Compact for Interstate Sharing of Putative Father Registry Information SB63:**  
Allows for states to share the information of registered putative fathers.  
Bill status: On the Senate calendar waiting for a vote. #SB63
- **Air Quality Rules and Penalties SB64S01:** Increases air regulations and increases penalties for unlawful incineration.  
Bill status: Failed in Senate committee. #SB64

- **Carbon Monoxide Detections Amendment SB58:** Requires specific educational buildings used by students to be equipped with carbon monoxide detection.  
Bill status: Passed in the Senate. Heading to a House committee. #SB58
