






## LEARNING FROM THE PAST & HONORING PROMISES

- Defending democracy through support for Proposition 4, fair maps, and ballot integrity
- Standing against censorship and the erasure of history in schools, universities, and public spaces
- Holding state systems accountable for past failures
- Upholding the constitutional rights that allow all people to live safely, authentically, and with dignity
- Remembering Utah's full history, including its indigenous people & the generations of immigrants and refugees who built it
- Protecting Utah's constitutional authority and state sovereignty

## FACING TODAY'S REALITIES

- Lowering costs and improving economic security through living wages, pay transparency, worker safety, and consumer protections
- Stabilizing teacher pay, and strengthening schools while opposing diversion of public dollars
- Improving healthcare access, mental health services, and addiction response
- Modernizing the justice system and prioritizing public safety
- Opposing efforts to limit voting access, weaken courts, or manipulate election rules
- Protecting family stability and due process in immigration enforcement
- Expanding access to high-quality and affordable childcare
- Ensuring statewide homeless response and resources connect people to services while creating pathways to stable housing
- Addressing immediate child safety risks to protect physical integrity and prevent abuse

## SAFEGUARDING UTAH'S FUTURE

- Protecting the Great Salt Lake, clean air, and water
- Investing in children through education, mental and behavioral health support, and welfare protections
- Planning responsibly for growth and the 2034 Olympics
- Ensuring public resources and funds are used responsibly with future generations in mind
- Investing in long-term childcare, food security, and health care access
- Standing against efforts to sell off, privatize, or transfer public lands
